Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's Gospel reminds us to be humble in our faith. We must recognise that we are sinners when compared the holiness of God. It is through prayer and reconciliation that God welcomes us back into His presence. Our lives are made free by God's mercy and not to our own goodness.
