NEWSLETTER THOUGHT

Walking in Gratitude

In the Gospel of Luke (17:11–19), we hear the story of ten lepers who cry out to Jesus for mercy. All are healed as they go, yet only one, a Samaritan, returns to give thanks. Jesus asks, "Were not ten made clean? Where are the other nine?" The one who comes back is praised not only for being healed, but for having faith that recognises grace and responds with gratitude. His turning back is more than politeness; it is the willingness to show gratitude, a return to God.

This Gospel offers a profound echo in the story of St. James the Greater, the apostle whose name is carried to the far west in Santiago de Compostela. James was among Jesus' closest friends and the first of the apostles to give his life in witness to the Gospel. The ancient Camino, the pilgrimage route to his resting place, invites every traveller to walk that same journey of faith, praying along the way, making each step purposeful, trusting in God who heals and leads us home.

Like the healed Samaritan, many pilgrims set out seeking mercy, healing, and renewal. Along the way, many discover something even greater: the joy of gratitude. Each sunrise on the path, every shared meal, and each act of kindness from fellow pilgrims become reminders of God's grace, His love and presence along the way.

When the road ends at Santiago, the true pilgrimage begins within. Gratitude turns walking into worship, and faith into thanksgiving. The Samaritan's return to Jesus mirrors every pilgrim's return to the heart of God. It beckons you, knocking at your heart, wanting you to open both your heart and your mind to love, that is Christ.

May our own journeys, whether long or short, teach us to see with thankful eyes, to trust like St. James, and to live with hearts that never tire of saying, "Thank you, Lord."
