Place the completed cards in the basket provided in the narthex and these will be placed before the altar during November as a sign of Remembrance. Our Books of Remembrance are available to view in Sacred Heart and St. Edmund.

We pray for those who are ill in mind and body. May they find comfort and hope in the tender love of Jesus. We also pray for those who care for them, that they may be blessed with the gifts of gentleness and patience.

Admittance to Hospital?

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.

Parking at Sacred Heart

We do advise EVERYONE to park in our car park when coming along to Masses or events at Sacred Heart. Do not park in our 'Drop off zone' or on any double yellow lines in London Road, as you could be ticketed. The King's Arms affectionately known as 'KA' to the young people, is a charity that has been set up to meet the needs of the young people of Petersfield and Alton and their surrounding villages. We run a range of different clubs for different age groups and have loads of cool things for them to do from arts and crafts, cooking or just having space to chill! We want the young people of this region to fulfil their potential and know their worth. Our hope is that the young people will take ownership of their club and help us to turn it into something that meets their needs and inspires them to get the best out of life!



On **Sunday 30 November** after the 9am Mass at St. Edmund, Dom Clarke (Horndean Development Lead and Senior Youth Worker), will be speaking on the essential work of the charity.

Then on **Tuesday 2 December** between 11am-12noon the KA will be holding a Coffee Morning at St. Edmund. This event has been planned and will be run by the young people who are currently a part of either our "Thrive" or "Aspire" Mentoring programmes in Horndean. The event is designed to give these young people confidence and a sense of achievement. They will be serving refreshments (tea, coffee and soft drinks) with Christmas biscuits and cakes in our own 'pop-up' café at the church.

It would mean an incredible amount to these young people if you could come along and will help also to showcase the work of The King's Arms with young people through our mentoring programmes. Thrive and Aspire are small group mentoring programmes for young people who struggle to be in school due to anxiety, worry or who have challenging behaviour.

Whilst at the coffee morning you can also discover more about The King's Arms work, our hopes and dreams for Horndean and much more from our youth workers and volunteers. I really hope also that the young people will be able to share a bit about their experience of being part of the KA family.
