REFLECTION

Reflection for Go upstream: Forming disciples to confront injustice

You've no doubt heard the story of the wise man who went to the river to meditate. When he arrived, he found a group of agitated people gathered on the riverbank. As he drew closer, he saw them frantically wading into the water to rescue people from drowning. Every time they pulled someone to shore, more flailing bodies came rushing downstream, crying for help.

After watching for a moment, the wise man asked what they were doing.

"Are you blind?" one of them shouted. "Can't you see we're saving people from drowning? We've been at this for hours!"

The wise man nodded. "It's a great thing you're doing," he said. "But perhaps it would be even more helpful to send some of your group upstream to find out why people are falling into the river in the first place."

That, in a nutshell, is the point of Pope Leo's recent apostolic exhortation found here : https://tinyurl.com/3zvsn8kv *Dilexi te* ("I have loved you").

As noted in *Encountering the poor is a prerequisite of faith* https://tinyurl.com/4uvbxy6w, the heart of the pope's message is this: caring for the poor is not merely a consequence of faith—it is a prerequisite of faith and an essential aspect of the Church's mission.
