Fr. Tom writes... LET'S MAKE ADVENT GREAT AGAIN

Someone once told me of a T-shirt they had seen at a music festival: JESUS IS COMING – LOOK BUSY.

Psychologists tell us that humour taps into subconscious concerns of which our conscious mind may be only dimly aware. Who knows what the motives of the person wearing that T-short were, but most of us know, if we're honest, that if Jesus Christ walked into the room right now, we would be so acutely aware of things we wished we had sorted out about ourselves, that we might not rush straight into his arms?

And yet we sing every Sunday that He is our Saviour and Friend. And each Mass we receive Him with reverence in the Blessed Sacrament.

Bridging the gap between what we sing and what we are, is what Advent is all about. There is no need here to bemoan the ever-earlier start of commercial Christmas. We can all see with our eyes the madness of it, and the hollow motives behind it. But if you would like to get into the true spirit of Advent this year, try to make it to one of the candlelit Rorate Caeli Masses at 7am each Monday at Sacred Heart, or to one of the penitential Station Masses on Tuesday evenings, where there will be chance to receive the sacrament of reconciliation and socialise with other Catholics in the area – details in this newsletter.

Advent is a time of honesty, preparation, and rich silence. When we follow that spirit, Christmas, which (for the record) starts at the Vigil Masses on Christmas Eve, comes alive again.
