### THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

#### REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

8/9 November 2025

#### Fr. Tom writes...

I once heard the story of an American woman who accompanied her elderly father on a trip to a Pacific island where he had seen action in the campaign against the Japanese in World War II. In military terms, it had been a disaster. Soon after they had been dropped by submarine onto this particular island, it became obvious that the Japanese had not only spotted them, but were ready for them.

For years, her father had never told his daughter what happened, but back on the beach he broke down and told her why he had wanted to come all this way to pay his respects. Realising they were about to be overrun, his company commander and sergeant had ordered everyone back into the water, where the Navy was still submerged, while the two of them proceeded to attack the Japanese post alone. Both were killed, but gave the others time to escape.

Acts of knowing self-sacrifice like that are unspeakably moving even for those of us who were not involved. Jesus once said that there was no greater love than that of a man who would lay down his life for his friends. In time, of course, he would do exactly that, and he would do so not just for those around him on Good Friday, but for you and me. As little as we can comprehend the scale or significance of it, he saved us that day too.

As the nation commemorates Remembrance Sunday and Remembrance Day, we think especially of those (many of them volunteers and conscripts) of the Commonwealth who have died for our sake. May the Lord give us some of their spirit of courage and generosity in our Christian lives.

#### **Remembrance Sunday**

Poppies are available at both churches – you may have to ask someone if you can't see them at Sacred Heart, sorry for this inconvenience but we are being super careful with donation boxes being left out now. All donations to the Royal British Legion.

Poppies are worn as a show of support for the Armed Forces community. The poppy is a well-known and well-established symbol, one that carries a wealth of history and meaning with it. Wearing a poppy is still a very personal choice, reflecting individual experiences and personal memories. #### COP30

Philip Hayllar, Justice & Peace writes... We quote Pope Leo XIV – **God will ask if we have cultivated and** cared for the world that he created for the benefit of all and for future generations, and if we have taken care of our brothers and sisters – what will be our answer, my dear friends?

The Pope called for increased pressure on politicians, adding that citizens across the world need to take an active role in political decisions, saying "only then will it be possible to mitigate the damage done to the environment".

The 30<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Parties (COP30) will be held in Brazil from November 6 to 21, 2025. This conference is significant as it will gather world leaders, scientists, and civil society to discuss urgent actions needed to combat climate change. The conference will emphasize efforts to limit global temperature increases to 1.5C, the presentation of new national action plans (NDC's) and the progress on financial commitments made at previous conferences. Developing countries are receiving less than 10 per cent of the money they need to adapt to a world increasingly vulnerable to extreme weather – putting lives, livelihoods and entire economies at risk.

#### What can we do?

- 1. Pray for a successful outcome
- 2. Sign the petition to the Energy Secretary which can be found on the CAFOD website
- 3. Join the Global Day of Action we're taking to the streets for globally coordinated mobilisations on Saturday 15 November. Our local event will take place from 12 till 2 in Commercial Road Portsmouth by the fountain. While world leaders gather for the UN's climate summit, our call will echo through streets on every corner of the earth: this world is ours"!

#### First Holy Communion Programme 2026

Do you have a baptised child in Year 3 or above who could make their First Holy Communion in 2026? #### **Admittance to Hospital?**

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.


