### Reflection from Fr Elijah

**This 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent** our readings talk to us how God fulfils his promises in Christ, the Emmanuel, Godwith-us. Also, Joseph's obedient faith in accepting God's surprising plan to welcome Jesus, teaches us to trust in divine guidance, prepare our hearts with hope, humility, and love, for Christ who saves the world through faithful obedience.

At Christmas, we proclaim in the incardination that God became human in Jesus Christ, born of Mary, to dwell among us. Through his humble birth, God reveals saving love, restores humanity, conquers sin and death, and invites all people to share divine life, peace, mercy, hope, and joy forever with faith and gratitude.

Next, Sunday is the **Feast of the Holy Family**, which celebrates Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as a model of faith, love, and obedience. It teaches us that God sanctifies family life, calls households to prayer and service, and invites families to grow in holiness through mutual self-giving, trust, and faithful love rooted in Christ.

Lastly, on New Year's Day, we celebrate **Mary, Mother of God**, because she was chosen by grace to bear Jesus Christ. Her faithful "yes" model's perfect discipleship and obedience. Honoured by the Church, she intercedes for humanity and always leads believers to Christ.
