7th December 2025 AD Year A (Psalter Week 2)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. In the first part of Advent, our focus is very much on preparing for the coming of Christ. This is done, in the main, by repentance—making our confession and reconciling ourselves to the Father. We are called to change the pattern of our lives in order to be ready when Jesus comes again in glory. John the Baptist calls us to look again at our hearts and make sure that there is no obstacle in Jesus' path. Each of us must "Prepare a way for the Lord!
