Message from Fr Rob

Gaudate Sunday, coming from the Latin word for rejoice. There is a change in a sense of this season seen visibly symbolised by the lighting of the rose candle on the Advent wreath and the vestments worn by the Priest. The colour signifies an addition to the penitential season of solemn preparation with that of joyful anticipation, mirroring the shepherds' joy at the angels' announcement of Christ's Birth.
