REFLECTION

Reflection for the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A)

The Gospel this Sunday begins with a moment of change. John the Baptist has been imprisoned, and Jesus feels both the personal loss and the spiritual weight of it. John had prepared the way; now Jesus must step forward. But he does not step forward alone. He walks along the Sea of Galilee and calls ordinary people — fishermen at their daily work — into a new purpose. “Come, follow me,” he says, “and I will make you fishers of people.”

This simple invitation becomes the pattern for discipleship in every age. Jesus calls, not because we are perfect or prepared, but because the Kingdom needs willing hearts. The first disciples left their nets - the familiar, the secure, the predictable - and discovered a life they could never have imagined.

Across history, countless others have heard that same call. One of them was Mary Glowrey, an Australian woman whose life offers a gentle but striking example of what it looks like to follow Christ's invitation. Mary was gifted, intelligent, and successful, yet she sensed that God was asking more of her than a comfortable career. She allowed her life to be interrupted by compassion. She stepped away from what was familiar and offered her gifts where they were most needed. Her path eventually led her to India, where she served the sick and the poor with extraordinary dedication. She didn't set out to be remarkable; she simply kept saying yes to the next step Christ placed before her.

Mary Glowrey's story is not meant to make us feel inadequate. It is meant to remind us that discipleship is always a journey - one step, one decision, one act of courage at a time. She didn't do everything. She simply did what she could, with love, and God multiplied it.

In today's Gospel, Jesus begins his public ministry with the words, “Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.” Repentance is often misunderstood as guilt or self-reproach. But at its heart, repentance means realignment - turning toward God's vision for the world and allowing our lives to move in that direction. It is the quiet, steady work of letting Christ reshape our priorities, our habits, and our sense of purpose.

So this Sunday, the question is not whether we are ready to do great things. The question is much simpler: **What shoreline is Christ inviting us to leave?**

What nets - fear, routine, self-doubt, comfort - might we need to loosen our grip on? And where might our gifts, however ordinary they seem, become instruments of healing, compassion, or hope?

Jesus still walks along the shoreline of our lives. He still calls ordinary people into the - extraordinary work of love. May we, like those first disciples and like Mary Glowrey have the courage to take the next step he places before us.
