

## **Message from Fr Rob**

**Happy and Holy New Year to you all.**

Thank you sincerely for the many gifts, donations, and cards I received. If you were away over the holidays, I hope you had a blessed and restful time. My thanks also to everyone who helped prepare both our churches for the Christmas season, and to all who participated in and supported our liturgies.

As we look ahead to the new year, there is still much to be done. I am deeply grateful to all who have volunteered their time and talents over the past two years. I would like to thank Jason Clark and Paul Salisbury for taking on the maintenance and updating of the parish website and for establishing a social media presence for the parish, long overdue and well beyond my own expertise.

Among the many outstanding responsibilities, I will need to devote more time to the pastoral area. As Coordinating Pastor, I have not yet been able to give sufficient attention to developing the Bishop's Ten-Year Plan, which is now in its fourth year. As the Bishop noted in his recent letter, ten priests have died this year, with others retiring, and there are no new seminarians entering for our diocese. While England and Wales still have one of the highest priest-to-population ratios globally, it is clear that in the immediate and mid-term future we cannot sustain the former model of one priest per church, or even one priest per parish.

I ask for your prayers as we begin to address these challenges. I would also greatly value your thoughts, feelings, and suggestions, especially regarding possible solutions. Change is never easy, but it is sometimes necessary. Please pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, that our parish may continue to be inspired and led into the future, united with Christ in the body of His Church.


