### Fr. James writes...

It was a great joy on Tuesday evening to welcome to St Edmunds approximately one hundred parishioners with my brother clergy from around the Southeast Hampshire Pastoral Area. We began with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Sacrament of Reconciliation at 6pm followed by Mass at 7pm and a shared Supper. (This Tuesday's Station Mass is at St Colman's then at St Patrick's on the 17<sup>th</sup>)

One of the new clergy initiatives this year was to invite Deacon Nick to preach a series of homilies. This evening's homily created a great deal of conversation and gave us all food for thought. I would like to share a few things he shared on the virtue of humility.

*'If prayer is the foundation of our Lenten journey, humility is the posture that keeps us moving forward.'*  
*'Within the Church, humility protects unity. It reminds us all that the various roles and ministries are gifts not entitlements. All authority in the Church exists to serve the Gospel.'*

*True humility does not mean thinking less of ourselves; it means thinking of ourselves less.*
