Fr. Tom writes...

In 1969, the future Benedict XVI, Joseph Ratzinger, gave a now famous radio interview, in which he was asked about the future of the Church:

“From the crisis of today the Church of tomorrow will emerge, a Church that has lost much. She will become small and will have to start afresh more or less from the beginning...As the number of her adherents diminishes, so she will lose many of her social privileges...But when the trial of this sifting is past, a great power will flow from a more spiritualized and simplified Church... In a totally planned world, people will find themselves unspeakably lonely. If they have completely lost sight of God, they will feel the whole horror of their poverty. Then they will discover the little flock of believers as something wholly new. They will discover it as a hope that is meant for them, an answer for which they have always been searching in secret...It will be a more spiritual Church.”

It is a sobering thought that we might be “the little flock of believers” from whom people will increasingly seek solace. We know we are so imperfect ourselves; so weak in every way. And yet, if Ratzinger’s prophecy proves accurate, weakness (and knowledge of that weakness) may prove to be our greatest strength. For when it does not give way to despair or blame, weakness is close to humility, and humility is the key to all that God offers us. Put simply, a Church that is not arrogant or complacent is a Church ready to be enflamed afresh by the Holy Spirit. And what a thought that is! That, far from dying, the Western Church could be on the brink of perhaps its greatest era. ‘Cultural Catholicism’ may be vanishing even in our lifetime, but those of us who remain are surely no longer coming to Church because we think we ought to. We are coming because we want to, or because we need to. Just saying that much out loud puts us halfway to being able to share the hope we have in Jesus.

Admittance to Hospital?

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.
