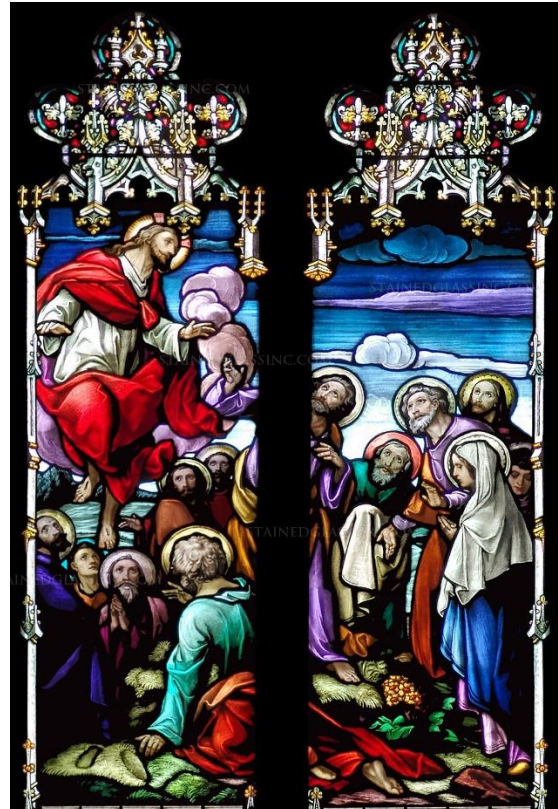

Cycle of Prayer: Summer

A Deeper Understanding between Christians and Jews, Those who suffer Persecution, Oppression, and Denial of Human Rights, Europe, Human Life, Seafarers

Jesus looks out over the crowds and feels compassion. They are harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. It is one of the most tender moments in Matthew's Gospel — God in human flesh, moved to his core by the suffering of ordinary people. His response is not pity but purpose. He turns to his disciples and tells them the harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few, and he urges them to pray that God will send workers into the field. Then he acts on his own prayer: he calls the Twelve, gives them authority, and sends them out. This pattern — seeing need, feeling compassion, responding with mission — is at the heart of Christian life. We are not called simply to admire Christ from a distance but to continue his work. The Kingdom of Heaven is announced wherever the sick are cared for, the lost are found, and the forgotten are named. This week, ask yourself where God is asking you to go. The harvest does not wait, and you are already equipped.

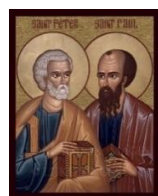
