### The Feast of Saints Peter & Paul

Today the Church joyfully celebrates two of her greatest pillars: Simon Peter, the fisherman whom Christ named the Rock, and Paul of Tarsus, the zealous convert who became the Apostle to the Gentiles. Though they were very different men — one rough-hewn and impulsive, the other a learned Roman citizen — both were utterly transformed by their encounter with the risen Lord.

Peter received from Christ the keys of the Kingdom and the charge to feed his sheep. Paul received a blinding vision on the road to Damascus and spent the rest of his life proclaiming what he had once tried to destroy. Together they carried the Gospel to the ends of the known world, and together they were martyred in Rome under Nero — Peter crucified upside-down, Paul beheaded — sealing their witness with their blood.

This feast, observed since at least AD 258, reminds us that the Church is built not on human strength but on grace. May the faith of Peter and the zeal of Paul inspire us to proclaim Christ boldly in our own time.
