Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul : 28TH JUNE 2020 AD: Welcome to St Patrick`s—This Sunday , we celebrate Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the two great pillars of the Church whose lives were transformed by their encounter with Jesus Christ. Peter, entrusted by the Lord to shepherd His flock, became a courageous leader despite his human weaknesses. Paul, once a persecutor of Christians, was converted by God's grace and became the great Apostle to the Gentiles. Through their faith, sacrifice, and unwavering witness, the Gospel spread throughout the world. The readings of today remind us that Christ continues to call ordinary people to extraordinary service. Peter's healing ministry and Paul's powerful conversion reveal the transforming power of God's grace. Their lives encourage us to trust in the Lord and respond generously to His call. May we, like Saints Peter and Paul, follow Christ faithfully and share His love and truth with all whom we meet.

This Sunday 28th June is the great Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul (transferred from Monday 29th to the adjacent Sunday). "Peter, a poor fisherman, was called by Christ to lead and care for Christ's entire flock: "Feed my sheep!" (John 21: 7). It was Peter who received a vision confirming that the Good News was to be preached to those the Jews considered unclean, the pagan Gentiles (cf. Acts 10: 9-16). Paul, the former Pharisee, carried out this missionary mandate. In the course of his preaching, he was flogged, beaten, stoned, shipwrecked and attacked by brigands (cf. 2 Cor 11: 24-27). Both Peter and Paul ended their ministries in Rome, around the year 64 AD. Tradition has it that Peter was crucified upside down and Paul was beheaded. What unites Peter and Paul is Jesus - His love for them and their love for Him" (Magnificat). On this feast day, please pray for the whole Catholic Church, for the Holy Father Pope Leo XIV, for all the clergy, religious and laity, for the unity of the Church and for its evangelising mission. A Very Happy Feast.
