Executive Headteacher of St Peter's Catholic Primary School and Oaklands Catholic School and Sixth Form College, Richard Cunningham writes... Well done everyone at St Peter's Catholic Primary School for taking part in "Wear a hat day" on Friday 22 May! The day was to raise awareness about brain tumours, a message which was shared with the pupils during assemblies that day. The school managed to raise £289 for the Brain Tumour Research charity. One in three people in the UK knows someone affected by a brain tumour. This disease is indiscriminate; it can affect anyone at any age. What's more, brain tumours continue to kill more children and adults under the age of 40 than any other cancer yet, to date, just 1% of the national spend on cancer research has been allocated to this devastating disease since records began in 2002. Thank you to all who were able to donate to a cause that is close to the heart of St Peter's.

Many of you are involved in parish ministries that would benefit from safeguarding insights, even if your ministry does not require an Enhanced DBS Disclosure. It is a great opportunity to meet other like-minded individuals and share ideas. We all have safeguarding responsibilities towards our fellow citizens. These sessions enhance our insights and increase our understanding about those children and adults who are considered vulnerable. The aim of this session includes identification of the nature of abuse, its signs and symptoms, and the way in which safe strategies can be put into place in our church.

Sacred Heart Car Park

It is really wonderful to see our community growing in numbers and we thank God for this. However, with increased numbers exceeding our car parking spaces, we would encourage those who are not elderly to consider parking close by and walking to church.

One option could be to park in an NCP car park, of which there are a number only 5-10 minutes walk from the church. JustPark is a useful app and you can also book a space using Your ParkingSpace as well as using the NCPLocator. Live navigation, such as Waze or Google Maps which will advise of nearby parking, especially during busier times. Your cooperation is very much appreciated.

Admittance to Hospital?

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.
