Fr. James writes...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Thank you to those that have signed up for Gift Aid in recent weeks and also reflected on your financial giving to our Parishes. As shared last week in my Pastoral letter, Bishop Philip announced a number of clergy appointments that will affect our Pastoral Area. These changes will take effect around September. I am confident that the new clergy team will continue to serve the faithful of our Pastoral Area with dedication and generosity. I will certainly miss you all and thank God for the opportunity to journey with you these past 5 years.

The appointments shared were as follows (in alphabetical order):

- **Deacon Craig Aburn** will serve as Deacon at St. Patrick's, Hayling Island (under Fr. Andrew Wagstaff).
- **Fr. Oliver Ezeani** (Archdiocese of Onitsha) has been appointed to St. Colman and St. Paul (under Fr Andrew Wagstaff)
- **Fr. Innaiah Maddineni** will move from St. Patrick's, Hayling Island, to St. Patrick's, Woolston, with The Annunciation, Netley, as Priest in Charge (under Canon Michael Dennehy).
- **Fr. Andrew Wagstaff** will move from St. Colman and St. Paul, Portsmouth, to Sacred Heart and St. Peter's, Waterlooville, with St. Michael's, Leigh Park, St. Edmund's, Horndean, and St. Patrick's, Hayling Island, as Parish Priest and Coordinating Pastor.

Further Studies

Fr. James Lewis will be away during the coming year to undertake further studies in Steubenville.

I am delighted that Fr. Andrew will be taking over from me. He knows the Pastoral Area well and is ideally placed to continue guiding us as we work towards becoming one canonical parish with the support of the other clergy.

Global Debt Campaign

Phillip Hayllar from Justice & Peace writes... At the end of Mass this weekend, we are collecting signatures for a CAFOD petition about the global debt crisis which is causing terrible suffering for our brothers and sisters around the world.

This is not only a financial issue; it is a moral one. A debt system that prevents vulnerable nations from investing in their people undermines justice, human dignity and long term-stability.

On behalf of CAFOD we would encourage you, as you leave the church that weekend to sign the petition, which you will find on the table in the narthex. This calls on the Prime Minister to tackle the global debt crisis by taking immediate action by:

1. Passing a UK Debt Justice Law – without delay (requiring wealthy banks in the City of London to participate in debt relief so they can no longer profit from countries struggling with unsustainable debts).
2. Lead urgent global reform (use the UK's G20 presidency to bring governments together to fix the broken global debt system and guarantee fast, fair and effective debt relief for countries in crisis)

Admittance to Hospital?

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.
