Fr. Tom writes...

I spoke recently with a Chinese nun who was telling me about life as a Catholic in China, which by all accounts is dreadfully difficult at the moment. She had not grown up amid the wealth and glamour of the coastal cities, but deep in the interior, where her father searches work each week as painter and farmworker. In a bid to stop the growth of the Catholic Church, the Communist Government has now banned anyone under the age of 18 from attending Mass. What this sister went on to say made me think. This ban, she said, was not the most damaging of the Government's moves to thwart the influence of the Church, since every historic act of persecution has so far drawn courage and inventiveness from the faithful. But, understanding this, the Government has now attacked from another angle. Now all parish priests have to take an oath of allegiance to the Communist Party, or else lose their right to work in a parish.

'They have attacked their consciences,' she explained, since many have signed the oath in order to continue their ministry. But while persecution has often brought the faithful closer to Jesus, who was Himself persecuted, this false act of allegiance has disturbed the very soul of priests. They are uncomfortable, she said, and her parents' priest had admitted to her that he was struggling to pray. In 1 Timothy 1:5, St Paul writes: *The aim of our charge is love that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith.* Faith is not the only pillar of an effective spiritual life. Indeed, with an uncomfortable conscience, our faith can torment us, since we cannot fool ourselves, or God. When we experience the discomfort of a bad conscience in our permissive, Western society, we often divert the discomfort into grumbling about other things and other people, as if it is their fault that we are uncomfortable. Rather than admitting - like that poor priest - that what we have done is wrong. Let us pray for this priest, Fr Z, that the Lord will help him and his people.
